- 1. Will we still have virtual services on Sundays? Yes, weekly virtual service will continue. We plan to move to one platform in the future which will be YouTube live. We even have a channel for our Generation Next group. Please continue to tune in, share, and subscribe.
- 2. Are the WOW activities for LCC only or open to the community? Thank you for asking! As with most things LCC, the WOW activities include an outreach component. That means invite members of the community, friends, and family. In order to limit the number of attendees per event, you may be asked to register to attend. - 3. What precautionary measures will be out in place for the WOW events? (le masks, social distancing, etc) We Will adhere to government COVID-18 restrictions including: social distancing, face coverings, limited attendance, etc.
- 4. Should we continue to give our tithe and offering? Please do. We believe the tithe is the responsibility of the believer to help support the local church. Although we will no longer be in a particular building, now is the time for us to increase our outreach efforts. Your tithe and offering will help support the accomplishment of the goals God has given us. As God spoke through the prophet Malachi (Malachi 3:10), tithing is an act of obedience that provides resources to the local ministry to carry out God's will. - 5. What about the equipment we purchased with the GoLive funds? Don't worry. Your funds were used for exactly what we were planning for our GoLive efforts. Because of your generosity we were able to move to virtual services sooner than we had planned. We purchased cameras, lights, a computer, and sound equipment. These items will continue to be used in our virtual and WOW environment.
- 6. How will the financial contributions be reallocated? We are currently reassessing our budgets to determine how we will reallocate funds to help support the virtual and WOW efforts that are forthcoming. The majority of funds will be saved and invested to position LCC to build or purchase a new facility in the near future.



- 7. Why are we exiting the building? We are exiting the building during this period of time for several reasons.
- We are in the middle of a pandemic that has, and will (for the forseeable future) prohibit us from safely meeting.
- The lease for our current space is expiring, and we felt paying for a space that is utilized for 8-10 hours per month isn't a judicious use of the ministry's resources.
- We believe God is directing us to focus on our virtual platform to worship and share His Word beyond the church walls!
- By exiting the building, LCC is able to save, invest, and prepare to build or purchase a new facility in the near future.
- 8. **Do we anticipate we will return to the same location?** It is doubtful that LCC will return to the same location since the lease is not being renewed. We plan to build or purchase a new facility in the Collin County area in the near future.
- 9. Will we ever return to a building? Yes! God is accelerating our plans to build and/or purchase our own facility. In the short term, funds will be saved and invested to position us to do just that!
